



## *Nomination for the E. Jack Lancaster Medal*

*The E. Jack Lancaster Medal is presented to the individual who has been recognized by the Society for dedication, leadership, and outstanding contributions to the International Fraternity of Quality Professionals.*

### **Award Criteria:**

The E. Jack Lancaster Medal Committee may propose someone who has demonstrated exceptional leadership, outstanding contribution, and dedication on the international scene in promoting the quality profession. The candidate must be a true quality professional with an international reputation and integrity. The committee may propose only one individual each year for the medal. The committee may also choose not to propose an individual on any given year. The nominated individual need not be a member of the ASQ. Individuals may not nominate themselves. They must have a sponsor. The sponsor need not be from the candidate's country.

Candidates submitted in previous years, but not selected, may be considered two additional times. Previous applications with supporting material are kept on file in Milwaukee and need not be sent again. The candidate's *sponsor* must, however, complete a new request form each time.
